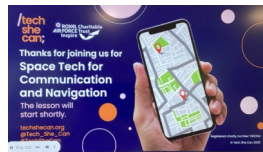
Wake up Wednesday

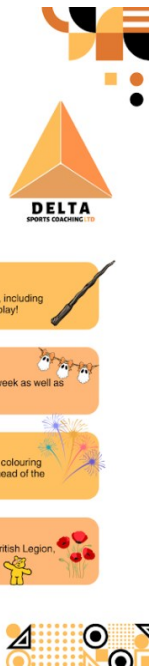
