Dear Parents/Carers,

KS1 educational visit to the Sealife Centre, Birmingham – Thursday 12th February

As you may be aware, the pupils in Key Stage 1 have been enjoying their “Poles Apart” unit of enquiry in which they have been learning about polar regions and the animals they would find there.

In order to bring their learning to life and to enhance their understanding, we have arranged for the children to visit The Sealife Centre in Birmingham on Thursday 12th February. During the day, the children will have opportunities to develop their knowledge of different ocean habitats and the creatures that live in them, as well as taking part in an explorers’ workshop which will provide more in-depth learning opportunities in this area.

The children will travel by coach, **leaving school promptly at 9am and return by 3.15pm** in time for the end of the school day. They will need to wear full school uniform, including a waterproof coat. In addition, they will need to bring a healthy packed lunch and pre-filled water bottle (no fizzy drinks or sweets please) in a rucksack or bag which they are able to carry themselves. If you would like to order a packed lunch from Aspens, our school caterer, please ensure that you place your order online by Tuesday 10th February so that it is delivered to school the day before the visit.

The cost of this visit is £5.75 per pupil which is kindly supported by the Friends of Himbleton and kindly ask that payment is made on School Money. Although payments for educational visits are voluntary, please be aware that the visit may not be viable and therefore may not be able to go ahead if we do not receive sufficient funds to cover the cost of the visit.
