Dear Parents/Carers,

Please see attached the details of our after school clubs which can be booked for the first half of the Summer Term 2026. Please note that there are clubs available for pupils from Reception to Year 6 and that these will run for **5 weeks from when we return from the Easter holidays, from the week beginning 13th April 2026 to the week beginning 11th May 2026, with the exception of clubs on a Monday which will continue until Monday 18th May due to May Day bank holiday when school is closed.** Towards the end of the first half of the Summer term, we will share information about clubs for the second half of the summer term.

Cookery Club:

*Cookery club will continue in the summer term but will be open to children in **Year 1 and Year 2.** This takes place in school and is run by an external provider, Emma Hall at Pudding and Pie. This club is bookable directly with her from 8.00pm this evening; please find details of how to do this on the separate letter also sent today. Spaces for this club are limited and are on a first-come, first-served basis. In the second half of term, this club will be available to children who were unable to secure a place in the first half of the summer term in the first instance.*

Lego Club:

This is being run by Delta Sports as part of our Wraparound Care offer. Children will work on a project to design and build models to a brief that they are given.

Board Games Club:

This is also being run by Delta Sports as part of our Wraparound Care offer and is available to children across the school. A range of fun board games will be available for children to enjoy.

Rounders:

A staple summer game in the sunshine, this club will build on throwing and catching skills whilst introducing children to a fun, competitive team game.

Cricket:

Last term, Worcestershire Cricket Foundation worked with our older children. This half term they will be holding taster sessions for EYFS and KS1 children in school and then a club for these year groups after school.

Booking and club arrangements:

- All clubs must be booked by returning the attached form to the School Office by **Monday 23rd March** so that places can be allocated during the last week of term.
- Parents and carers will be notified if there is not a space available in a club and an alternative offered, if possible. If a place has been allocated, a payment item will be available to view by **Thursday 26th March.**
- As places on a most clubs are limited, payment must be made in order to secure the booking. If payment is not made, the place will be unavailable at the club and may be offered to another child.
- Unfortunately, once booked and paid for, club bookings are not refundable and if a child is signed up for a club, we do ask for commitment to this for the half term, other than in exceptional circumstances.
- All after school clubs will run until **4.15pm** and children should be collected from the playground at this time, unless they are attending after school care following the activity.
- If, once a place is secured, your child is unable to attend a club one evening for any reason, please ensure that this is communicated with the class teacher or school office as soon as possible.
- Children attending sporting clubs should bring either their school PE kit or a change of clothes in order to be able to participate fully, especially if a club is taking place on the school field.
- As they are expected to do so in school, children attending after school clubs are expected to show our values towards the staff who run clubs and make positive choices of behaviour. This is so that all children can enjoy this experience fully. If we become concerned about the behaviour during a club, we will contact parents and carers to agree a way forward.

As always, after school care is available from the end of the school day until 6.00pm every day. Children who attend this club enjoy a range of activities including sporting activities, time on the adventure playground, crafts, cooking, puzzles and much more. If this is something you are interested in, please contact Mrs Stewart in the school office.
